#### Data Protection Act—Now call **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** and what it means to us.

We are still waiting on the final guidance notes but it seems that it is going to be a fairly easy and manageable law for us to comply to.

In the coming weeks, all members and friends of the church will receive a form where they confirm their details and note any changes. You will tick a box if you would like to be included in the directory and sign it. We will go through this process every year. Forms will be kept in a locked cabinet and information on the computer will be password protected and only accessible to with the authority to do so.

### For members who have paper directories, it is your responsibility to destroy any previous out-of-date ones that you have. These should not be kept as a keep sake. I am happy to shred old ones if you bring them in to the office.

In the past, we have published Pastoral news. This is something we can continue to do but there will be slight changes. For example, rather than saying "Christine is at Stepping Hill and will be moving to Newlands care home". We will say "Christine is in hospital will be moving to a care home". There won't be much difference but the specifics about where I am will be omitted and surnames will not appear.

The purpose of Pastoral news is for those on it to be included in our prayers. Don't forget, **PRAYER IS POWERFUL**! We can pray for you even if you do not want your name published. We can simply write "One of our members is undergoing tests". We have a prayer group that meets every month and another one that meets on Sunday mornings before the service. Prayer requests can also be made using the prayer table beside the office.
