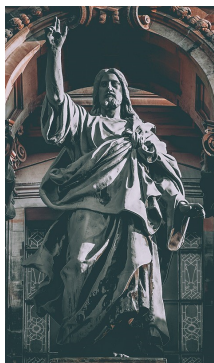

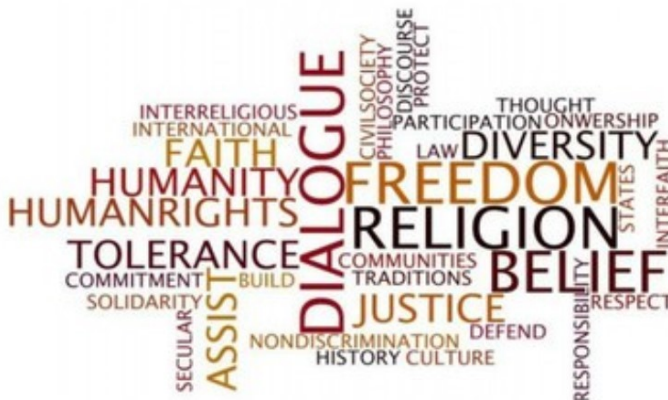
## A Back to Basics Tour of the Bible (Around the bible in eight sessions)

Tombola prizes still needed by next Wednesday.

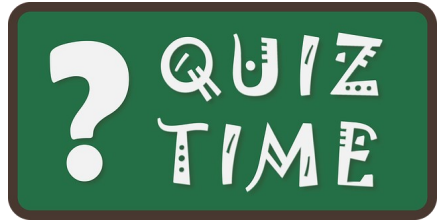
