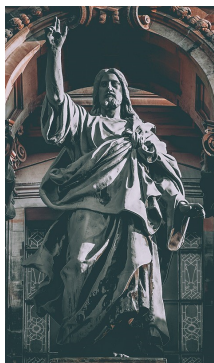

Go to do God's will and not ours.

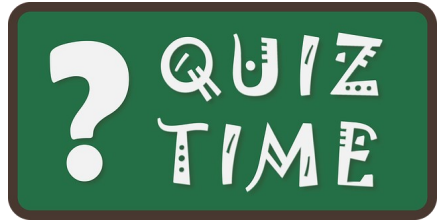
We go seeking the eternal – not living for material things, but living with them and using them to help all to see God.
