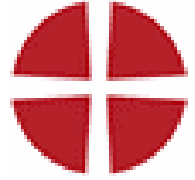

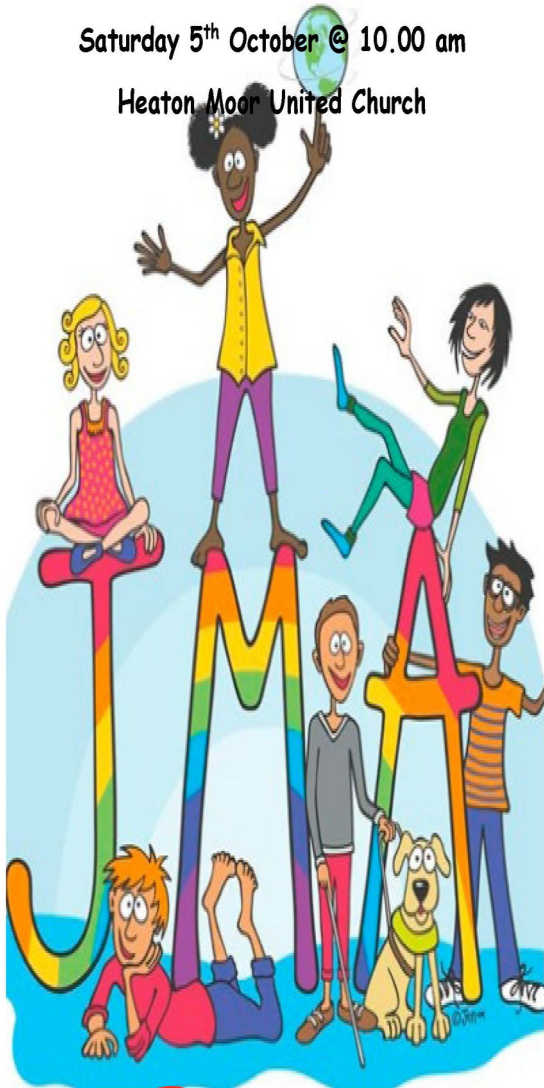
IF YOU HEAR THE FIRE ALARM
