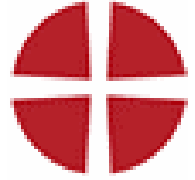

May your Holy Spirit give us the courage to resist evil in all its forms and show us how to be peacemakers through prayer and action,

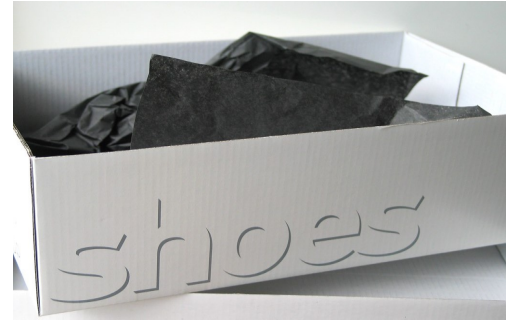
lest we forget those who fought, suffered and died that we might have the freedom and peace we enjoy today.
