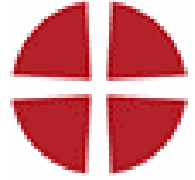

Evacuate the building using your nearest exit and assemble on the lawn.

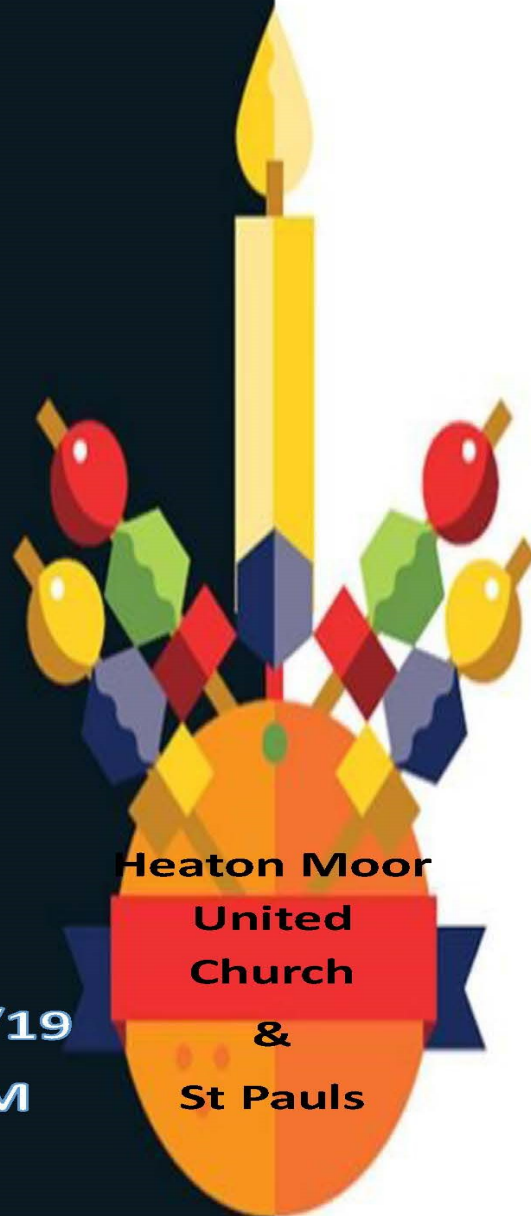
