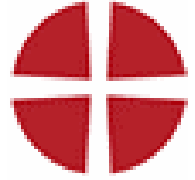


3rd Sunday in Advent
