to serve on those dates.

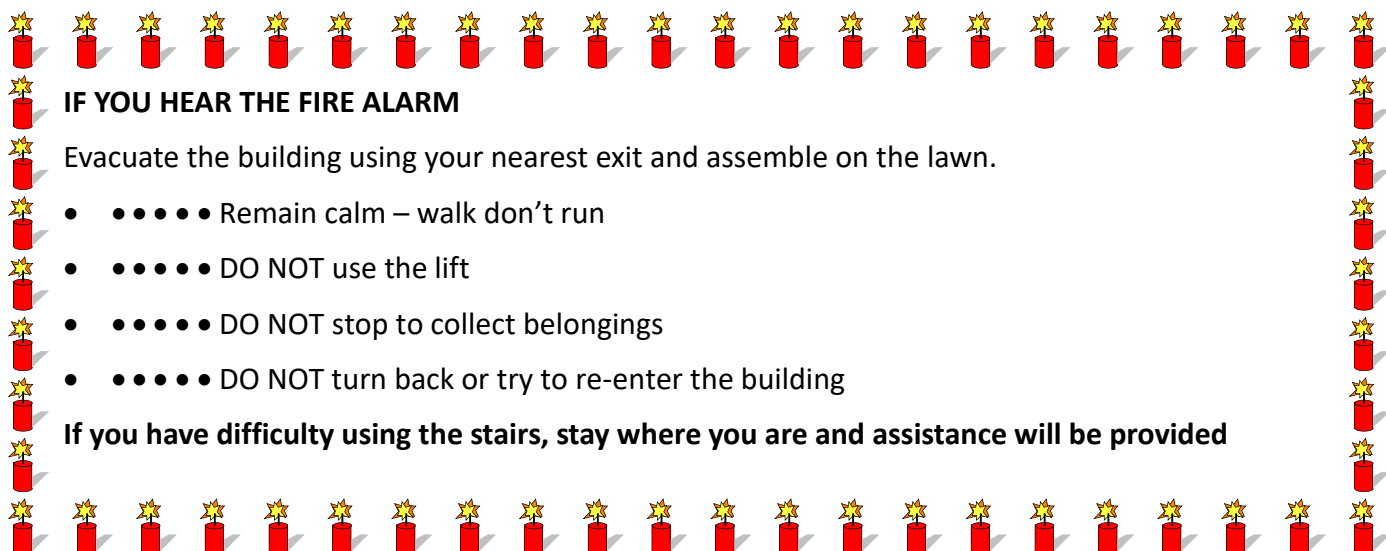
